Come along and meet members of Marshwood CLT who are keen to gather information about local housing need.

Find out about the local housing register and how to apply. We can also talk to you about available assistance with rent and council tax should you be on a low income and worry that rent would not be manageable.

If you are in housing need, with a local connection to the school catchment area with a family income of less than £60,000 you CAN register for local affordable housing. Shared equity housing is an option being considered but you need to be registered.

If you wish to join the local housing register then you can access the internet during the session to complete an on line application (easiest and quickest way) or complete a paper one. Members of the CLT will be available to assist you if needed in complete confidentiality.

Help us to help you effectively by telling us about your housing needs.

Please share this information with others you may know who need affordable housing.

If you are considering registering for the housing list please bring the following to be photocopied:

- National Insurance Number
- Proof of local connection
- If you are faced with losing your current accommodation please bring letters to support this ie notice to quit letter.

Details of income:

- Pay and/or benefits, a current bank statement showing child benefit or a letter of entitlement for the benefit.

ID:

- Passport, Driving Licence or Birth certificate (1 needed)

Proof of address: Current:

- Utility or Council Tax bill, Bank/building society statement, College/school letter, payslip with address, letter from Department for Work & Pensions, Tenancy Agreement (if signed in the past 4 weeks) mobile phone account, letter confirming housing benefit at current address. (1 needed)
